Remember to turn in your community service hours. If you don't have access to enter your time online, let me know and I will enter your hours for you.

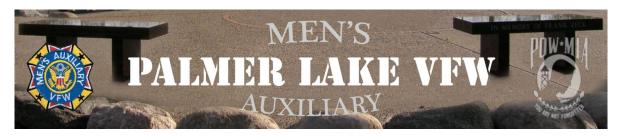
